La Llorona Weeps: Traumatic grief, sandplay and neural integration


PRESENTER: Lorraine R. Freedle, PhD, ABPdN, CST-T

Drawing from the work of prominent neuroscientists and original research, Dr. Freedle will also review the effects of trauma on the brain and explain how sandplay therapy facilitates neural integration and transformative healing in the wake of traumatic grief.

Presenter: Dr. Lorraine R. Freedle is a clinical social worker, pediatric neuropsychologist, and international sandplay therapy teacher (STA/ISST). She is the Clinical Director of Pacific Quest, a holistic outdoor behavioral health program in Hilo, Hawai`i where she also maintains a private practice, Black Sand Neuropsychological *Services. She is on faculty at Southwestern* College in Santa Fe, NM. Dr. Freedle has published numerous professional journal articles and chapters, and is an awardwinning researcher for her studies of sandplay therapy with adults with traumatic brain injury and youth with co-occurring trauma and addiction. She currently serves as Research Editor for the Journal of Sandplay Therapy.
